



Bilingual chanteuse, songwriter, producer, multi-instrumentalist and educator Laura Rae dances between languages and genres, influenced equally by soulful Norah Jones as rock legend Sheryl Crow. Since releasing her first single in 2021, Laura has been nominated for Music Nova Scotia's Prix de l'Acadie 2023, New Artist Recording of the Year 2022, and has taken home bronze for Halifax The Coast Best Folk Artist 2022. Her debut French Album *Chansons pour ma grand-mère* (2023), "feels like a lost EP

from Feist's early days—if the 'Mushaboom' singer went en français for a minute" (The Coast). In 2024 she released 4 singles and has an album on the way. Laura's live show includes acoustic guitar, dynamic electric guitar, and live-looped vocals sure to impress.
